## **Getting Started: Creating a USAJOBS account**

- 1. Go to the USAJOBS website: www.usajobs.gov
- 2. Click on the "Sign In" or "Create Account" button.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to create your account.
- 4. Remember your username and password; you'll need them to log in later.

## Search and filter internship listings

- 1. Log in to your USAJOBS account.
- 2. Use the search bar to enter keywords related to your interests (e.g., "marketing internship" or "forestry laborer").
- 3. To refine your search results, use filters like:
  - a. Location: Specify the city, state, or region.
  - b. Agency: Choose a specific government agency.
  - c. Job Type: Select "Internship" or "Student Program" under "Work Schedule."
  - d. Click the "Search" button to view internship listings.

## **Review Listings**

- 1. Click on an internship listing that interests you to view its details.
- 2. Read the job announcement carefully for application instructions and requirements.
- 3. Prepare the necessary documents, such as a tailored résumé and cover letter.
- 4. Submit your application following the specified process, which may include an online application or mailing documents.
- 5. If you are not ready to apply, save the listing using the "Save" feature indicated by the star icon.
